Oneida County Health Department Environmental Health Program Support of Businesses During Safer At Home

The Oneida County Health Department (OCHD) continues to work with licensed and inspected businesses such as restaurants, hotels, motels, tourist rooming houses, bed and breakfast, and campground facilities, etc., during Governor Evers Safer at Home order. The Safer at Home order allows some facilities such as restaurants to remain open to provide take-out and delivery of food; hotels, motels, tourist rooming houses, and bed and breakfast establishments to provide needed housing for construction workers and medical staff; and campgrounds for people seeking to get into the outdoors.

OCHD is working hard to help businesses during this difficult time. We are dedicated to solving problems, providing handouts, and ensuring we are in constant contact with facilities to not only facilitate business but also protect public health. Below you will find a list of some steps OCHD is taking to do this:

Licensing and Fees

- Deferred payment of facility fees that are due on June 30th2020, until December 31, 2020

Promoting Businesses

- Updated our Facebook page and our website to let people know their food is safe to order from our restaurants

Protecting Public Health

- Continuously provide information to restaurants regarding employee health topics
- Started a virtual school food inspection program to help our schools, especially those still serving food during COVID-19, continue to meet Department of Public Instruction (DPI) requirements for providing safe food
- Working both in-person and virtually with restaurants and lodging facilities, to help them open, and remain open, during this difficult time

OCHD will continue to help businesses navigate through these difficult times. We will help businesses start to reopen during the “phase-in” period by providing information on cleaning, sanitizing, employee and community health, as well as any other needs local businesses may have.
