ONEIDA COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT BEGINS VACCINATING 65+

Oneida County Health Department (OCHD) is excited to announce vaccination efforts have begun for individuals 65 years and older. In coordination with community partners, OCHD began community vaccination clinics on January 29, 2021. Getting vaccinated will help keep you, your family, and your community healthy and safe.

At 95% efficacy, the vaccine is extraordinarily effective at protecting you from the virus. To sign up for a vaccine with Oneida County Health Department, please go to oneidacountypublichealth.org or call 715-401-4150. As COVID-19 vaccines are received by OCHD, people who are eligible to receive the vaccine and have completed the sign up form will be contacted with a date for them to receive their vaccine. Appointments are required for all COVID-19 vaccinations.

Please keep in mind that it will take time to get everyone safely vaccinated. Wait times should be expected at community clinics. Our local healthcare systems and pharmacies will also be helping provide these vaccinations. Community members are encouraged to use all potential avenues for vaccination. We ask that you please check with those sources for their specific updates.

As vaccination efforts continue OCHD will provide additional updates. There are no wait lists being formed for vaccines in future phases. People are encouraged to stay up to date on vaccine information by monitoring the Oneida County Health Department website (oneidacountypublichealth.org) or Facebook page (facebook.com/OneidaCountyHealthDepartment/).
